# **Guidelines for Poster Presentation**

### 1. Poster Dimensions

- Size: The poster should be printed in A0 size (33.1 Wx 46.8 inches
  H)
- Orientation: Posters should be in portrait orientation.

### 2. Poster Content

- **Title**: The title should be at the top of the poster in large, bold font (suggested size: 72 pt). Include the full title of your paper as submitted in the conference.
- **Authors**: List the names of all authors, along with their affiliations. The presenting author's name should be highlighted. It should also be highlighted that whether the presenting author is a **student**.

## 3. Design Guidelines

### Font Size:

Title: 72 pt (or larger)

o Section Headers: 36 pt

o Body Text: 24 pt

o Captions: 18-20 pt

• **Color Scheme**: Use a consistent, professional color scheme. Ensure that there is enough contrast between the text and background for readability.

# • Images and Graphics:

- Use high-resolution images.
- Charts and graphs should be clearly labeled with legends and axes.
- Avoid overcrowding the poster with text and use bullet points and visuals to convey information succinctly.
- One should not just copy full submitted paper in the poster.

 Please understand that you have to explain your work in an efficient way to the audience.

## 4. Poster Printing

- **Responsibility**: Posters should be printed by the presenter following above mentioned guidelines printed on a high-quality paper with a matte or satin finish.
- It is also advised that one full A0 size paper should be used for printing posters and not multiple pages of smaller sizes.

## 5. Poster Display

- Posters are scheduled to be displayed on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> November 2025 only. Poster sessions will be scheduled in the evening of these two days. Dates and Timings of the posters as per poster ID shall be uploaded on the website along with the conference schedule.
- The poster presentation area will be clearly marked at the conference venue. Also, one should stick posters exactly according their poster ID.
- Presenters should be available to discuss their posters during the designated poster session times.

#### 6. Best Student Poster Awards

Conference Organizing Committee has decided to give away Best Student Poster Awards as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Cash Prize	Rs. 15000/-	One
2 <sup>nd</sup> Cash Prize	Rs. 10000/-	Two
3 <sup>rd</sup> Cash Prize	Rs. 5000/-	Two

#### 7. Student Poster Evaluation Criteria

Posters will be evaluated based on:

Clarity and organization of content.

- Visual appeal and design.
- Depth and originality of research.
- Presenter's ability to explain and discuss the poster.
